ARTICLE VIII (BOARD OF GOVERNORS)

The Board of Governors shall consist of the Commodore and eight (8) elected members. Four (4) of the eight (8) elected members shall be elected annually for a term of two (2) years. The Commodore shall serve for one (1) year or until succeeded. Elections shall be held at the September membership meeting
Change To Read:

The Board of Governors shall consist of the Commodore, eight (8) elected members and the two (2) license holders. Four (4) of the eight (8) elected members shall be elected annually for a term of two (2) years. The Commodore shall serve for one (1) year or until succeeded. Elections shall be held at the September membership meeting. The two (2) license holders shall only have a vote on Liquor board matters only.

ARTICLE XXIII (CHITS)

Primary and Social Members shall be required to purchase one hundred eighty (180) dollars of chits per year. Chits are to be used exclusively for food or drink, excluding Opening Day Weekend or tickets for special events.

Change To Read:

Primary and Social Members shall be required to purchase two hundred (200) dollars of chits per year. Chits are to be used exclusively for food or drink. excluding Opening Day Weekend or tickets for special events.

Through the efforts of Rob Knickman, a system of inventory controls has been established for the bar. The preliminary results indicate that goods are being stolen from the bar. To a member, the board wishes the thief or thieves to know that if this does not stop immediately further action and resources will be expended to identify and expel them from our club.

The membership is urged to begin saving their nickels and dimes to pay their annual bill due January 31st. Late payment will likely have severe consequences.

The November and December Board Meetings have been moved to the third Thursday of the month because of the

Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays.

At the last board meeting, there was a discussion about inventory. This committee will be meeting and working on reducing inventory while trying to maintain the popular drinks most members enjoy.
