Bar Report

Bar Committee -P/C Jerry Selig, P/C John Cashman

We had our Liquor License hearing on Monday, December 17 at 2:45pm and all went well as expected. The transaction of \$133,000 will take place in 2013 so we do not have a tax liability of \$32,000 for this year.

We have had inspections by Baltimore County to include plumbing, building, fire and health departments. A report will be given at the Jan. 4th general meeting.

The following items are the changes since we now have a private liquor license:

1. Red Eye cannot sell carry out related to beer/alcohol, however, food products/sodas can be purchased with your chits
 2. Children can stay in clubhouse (dining side only), deck and grounds after 9:00pm with adult supervision.
 3. No rentals to outsiders with the use of our bar.
 4. We will have a guest book available at the bar for guest.
- What is a guest, anyone not a member of our club or any other yacht club. You have them sign the book and you can purchase their beverages and business as usual.

BALTIMORE COUNTY INSPECTIONS MANDATORY REPAIRS

1. Repair plumbing at the center urinal
2. Replace existing seats with "open" seats in ladies room bathrooms

3. Service all the fire extinguishers in building
4. Service kitchen suppression system and maintain every 6 months as required
5. Un-obstruct kitchen hood suppression system manual lever
6. Service emergency lights at front door and make sure they work
7. Repair the broken electrical receptacles in kitchen and basement
8. Replace missing electrical covers in kitchen and basement
9. Add the number 2222, at least 6" high on front of building for identification
10. Move the bar stools obstructing side exit to deck
11. Provide proper interior finish rating on walls - 2nd floor lounge and stairway leading to 2nd floor with at least a "B" interior finish rating
12. Pump hand soap at all hand wash sinks in bar and kitchen
13. All spray bottles must be labeled and must be stored at least 6" off floor
14. Silverware has to be in separate protected storage containers with all utensils in the same direction
15. All open food in refrigerator and freezer must be labeled what is inside and dated
16. Clean the refrigerator and freezer and keep in clean condition at all times
17. Open bags of food not sealed in air tight containers
18. Cooking equipment under hood needs deep clean and must stay clean at all times
19. Existing thermometer is not approved, must be in degrees 0-222 degrees - 2 degree increments
20. Kitchen hand washing sink is blocked - must be open at all times for proper hand washing
21. All items stored in building must be stored on approved shelving 6" off floor
22. Knives need to be stored on magnetic strip
23. Mops, brooms, dust pans etc. must be hung up in janitor's closet
24. Sinks in bar and kitchen are dirty - must keep clean at all times
25. Mold in basement must be removed and kept under control at all times
26. Dumpster not placed on hard service - need blacktop or concrete pad
27. Oil spill on ground in front of garage
28. Crab shack dirty. Have to cook outside. Remove grease under grill
29. HACCP plan must be created and maintained. Must be submitted to County for approval
30. Need test strips for 3-compartment sinks
31. Floors in restroom and bar area are in disrepair
32. Floor is rotten in men's bathroom and under beer coolers. Will need to be replaced. Must have permit and plumbing permit and become ADA complaint
33. Found undercoating in the bar cooler(s) which is not allowed. No spray coating of any type allowed

A special membership meeting will be held on January 19, 2013 from 1:00 PM until 5:00PM, partly to vote on a proposed by-law change. The change does two things. It permits the Club to charge each member up to \$660.00 each year to pay a mortgage and it permits each member to make quarterly payments.
