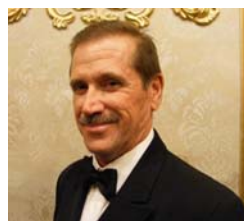

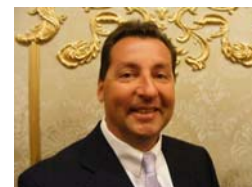

Article VII
Section 3

Change To Read

The Commodore or his representative shall be given a budget equal to the full price of two (2) tickets for attending each of the Commodore's Balls of other yacht clubs. The Commodore or representative will get reimbursed providing the visiting club attended our ball. The Commodore will decide which officers attend the balls of other yacht clubs. The person(s) attending must present his ticket or program to the Treasurer for reimbursement.

Article XIV

Section 1

Only Regular Primary and Secondary members in good standing shall be entitled to vote.

Section 1 change

Only regular Primary and Secondary members in good standing shall be entitled to vote. A member in good standing represents members that are current on all financial obligations.

Section 7

All members "in good standing" are eligible to vote on any matter. "In good standing" represents members that are current on all financial obligations.

Section 7 new

Members must have attended (4) general membership meetings in the last calendar year in order to vote. New members must attend (2) general membership meetings their first year in order to vote.
