wear a long sleeve shirt with a collar and the top button must be clasped -NO EXCEPTIONS. The following Saturday March the 17th we will host or better stated be taken over by some 80 strong Eastern Yacht Club members.

Our month ends with another dual land cruise this time we will be entertaining The Bush and Crescent Yacht Clubs. All members are encouraged to come down and participate and don't forget all of these cruises are the perfect opportunity to earn work hours, working behind the scenes as event staff. Let me know if you plan to work so that I can get your event staff shirt size ordered in time. The shirts are traffic lime green "Event Staff" or "Security Staff" orange and will be blazoned across the back with your name on the breast pocket. You must have at least one ear ring (no clip-ons please) and/or either a mullet style haircut or wig to be on staff. Now switching harbors for a minute. I have come to learn that as the REYC Fleet Captain people seek me out to discuss more than just the next cruise destination.

Namely the fear of being evicted from their slip to accommodate another member's boat. I think it would make sense if we grandfather all boats in their current slips as conforming. From there the club should measure and permanently post a chart in the club house that shows the size boats that are qualified to occupy each slip. Using that chart as a guide, let's not accept any new members for whom we do not have a conforming slip and further that regardless of seniority come next slip assignment circus no one may bid a slip for which their boat does not conform. While we are at it, it might be a good idea to institute an increased initiation with a three tier valuation on all slip fees to prospective members. We really need to have our dues reflect the value of the club in the market at the time of application. It might not be a bad idea either that in the future anyone who moves from their current grandfathered slip would then also be subject to the new three tier slip fee system.
