The pile driver is here and the pier work is in progress. The pier repairs have been completed and only minor tweaking of that work aspect remains. Many thanks to the members that stepped up to re-deck the finger piers that had to be reconstructed. The pile driver has also started to install pilings for the additional "new slips". He will then install stringers, whalers and decking. Once he has completed that part of the project we will need to complete the electric, water supply and cleat installation. Also, this past week, John Cashman and I worked on corrosion meter testing. A few boats were not in port and will have to be tested when they return. Others did not have a suitable ground and will need to be retested as well. Results of the testing will be available as an attachment in the newsletter and a hard copy will be posted in the club. Please check your boats status and make corrections as needed. Boats with little or no protection will adversely affect other boats in the area. If your boat requires a retest, please make arrangements with me.
